I got side tracked on my baby quilt that I told you about on Monday and I've been doing some tidying in the quilting room so not as much time got spent on my UFO project. That's okay.

These don't have a deadline and sometimes, that's the best kind of project to have.

For those who haven't been following along, I am making two Zuckerwatte quilts. One for each of my oldest childcare girls. The pattern is in Bonnie Hunter's String Fling book.



That's the center of quilt #1. I am bound and determined to work on these both at the same time not letting one quilt get finished first. I'm so afraid that if I finish one and not the other at the same time that the second quilt will just sit. The thrill of quilting is seeing the quilt come

together...I'm afraid I won't be as thrilled for the second quilt.

I got the centers sewn together and planned to iron these over nap time. Carver was playing his usual Carver trick and not napping with the other kids. I think he wants uninterrupted Grandma time. Typically I let him have it but this day these needed to be ironed. I put Carver in the dining room to play and before I knew it he was coming out to the kitchen where I was ironing. I quickly finished the first one, laid it out on the floor and snapped a picture. I put him back in the dining room. Then I went to iron top #2. Well he had noticed me when I took a picture of the first top and before I knew it I had a helper...



I was going to grab him and put him back in the dining room to play but I bent down to pick him up and saw this...
