


What I'm Reading: Bleed for Me

I just finished the audio book [Bleed for Me \(Joseph O'Loughlin\)](#) by Michael Robotham. I grabbed this book as I really liked a book had previously read by this author, [The Secrets She Keeps: A Novel](#).



I enjoy cop/suspense books...and this one was really good. If you're an audio book listener, you know that a reader can make or break a book. This one adds to it. Here's what Amazon has to say: *"When Sienna Hegarty, a troubled friend of his daughter, comes to Joe O'Loughlin's door terrorized, incoherent, and covered in blood, he vows to unearth the dark secrets her mind has buried. The police find*

a major piece of the puzzle at Sienna's house: her father, a retired cop, murdered.

Tests confirm that it's Mr. Herharty's blood on Sienna. She says she remembers nothing. Investigators take aim at Sienna. O'Loughlin senses something different is happening, something subterranean and terrifying to Sienna. It may be something in her mind. Or it may be something real. Someone real. Someone capable of the most grim and gruesome murder, and willing to kill again if anyone gets too close."

Amazon readers gave the book 4.4 stars. I think I'd go with 4.6. I am going to be on a watch to try to get the other books. I'm trying to be patient to see if the on line library might add a couple of them before I have to use a credit.
