

# Pin Up Star Table Runner



## Fabric Needed:

To make the table runner, you will need three completed star blocks.

Star block pattern here: <http://quiltinggallery.com/quilters-fun/between-heaven-and-texas-blog-hop/>

You will also need:

- 1 yard brown (similar tone to that used in the blocks)
- ½ yard neutral (same neutral as used in the block)
- Leftover colored scraps from making the blocks

## Cutting Instructions:

From the brown fabric, cut the following:


- 2- 7.5" squares—Subcut once on the diagonal to yield 4 triangles
- 1- 14.25" square—Subcut twice on the diagonal to yield 4 triangles
- 4- 2.5" x WOF strips

From the neutral background fabric, cut the following:


- 4- 2.5" x WOF strips

From the colored scraps, cut the following:

- 4- 3.5" squares in the same color



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## Sewing Instructions:


To make the side setting triangles:

1. Gather the triangles cut from the 14.25" square, two of the 2.5" neutral strips, and the scraps from making the star blocks. Subcut the scraps into 4- 3.5" square blocks (I used the green scraps).
2. Place a 3.5" square on the square corner of the triangle. Sew diagonally across the 3.5" square. Trim seam to .25" and press to the colored square (now triangle).




3. Cut each 2.5" strip into 2- 18" lengths to yield a total of 4- 18" strips.
4. Fold the 2.5" strip in half and pin to mark the middle of the strip. Fold the 18" strip in half and also pin to mark the middle.
5. With right sides together, pin the middle of the 2.5" strip to the middle of the triangle.
6. Sew the strip to the triangle. Press to the 2.5" neutral strip.

7. Using the edges of the triangle as a guide, trim the 2.5" strip portion to complete the triangle. Repeat to make 4 side setting triangles.



To make the corner triangles:

1. Gather the triangles cut from the 7.5" square and 1- 2.5" neutral strip.
2. Subcut the 2.5" neutral strip into 4- 9.5" strips.
3. With right sides together, sew a neutral strip to a short side of each of the 4 corner triangles.



4. Again, using the hypotenuse of the triangle, trim the 2.5" strip to complete the triangle.

To assemble the table runner:

1. Assemble as shown:



2. Using the remaining 2.5" neutral strip, cut 2-17.5" strips. Sew the 17.5" strip to either end of the table runner.
3. Quilt and bind using the 2.5" strips that were cut from the brown.
