

Finished Quilt Size: 83.5" x 83.5"
Finished Block Size: 10.5"



Fabric Requirements:

1 layer cake or two charm packs
3 yards white
1.5 yards pink
1 yard purple
2 yards turquoise
.75 yards print (binding)

Cutting Instructions:

Layer Cake--From each of 25 layer cake squares (or 2 matching charm squares)
--Cut 1- 5" square
--Cut 4- 2" squares

White

--Cut 21- 2" strips
--Cut 18 strips into 2" squares for 348 total
--Cut 6 strips into 2" x 5" rectangles for 48 total
--7 strips will be used for small white border
--Cut 11- 3.5" strips
--Cut 7 strips into 3.5" squares for 68 total
--Cut 4 strips into 3.5" x 5" rectangles for 24 total

Pink

--Cut 20- 2" strips
--Cut each strip into 2" squares for 400 total

Purple

--Cut 11- 2" strips
--Cut 2 strips into 2" squares for 28 total
--9 strips will be used for small purple border

Turquoise

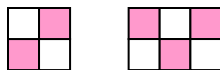
--Cut 9- 7.5" strips to be used for the large outer border

Biding

--Cut 9- 2.5" strips to be used for binding

Block Assembly:

--Using the 2" pink and 2" white squares, create a total of 32 pink and white 4-patches and 12 pink and white 2x3-patches.

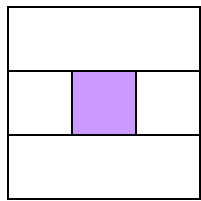


Purple Blocks--

1. Join a white 2" square with a purple square. Press to the purple.
2. Join a second 2" white square on the opposite side of the purple square. Again, press to the purple.

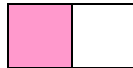


3. Attach a 2" x 5" white rectangle to the long side of the piece created above. Press to the white.
4. Attach a second 2" x 5" white rectangle to the opposite side of the block. Press to the white.



Printed Blocks--To Make one block

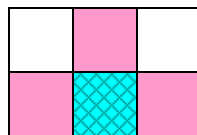
1. Using the cut 2" pink and 2" white squares, join 100 pink and 100 white squares to make 100- half 4-patches. Press all to the pink.



2. Join one pink 2" square to each printed 2" square. Press to the pink.

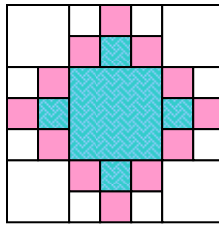


3. Using 2- half 4-patches from the previous step and 1 of the 2" pink and printed sets to create a 2x3 set. Make 4. Pile like printed 2x3 sets with the corresponding 5" square.

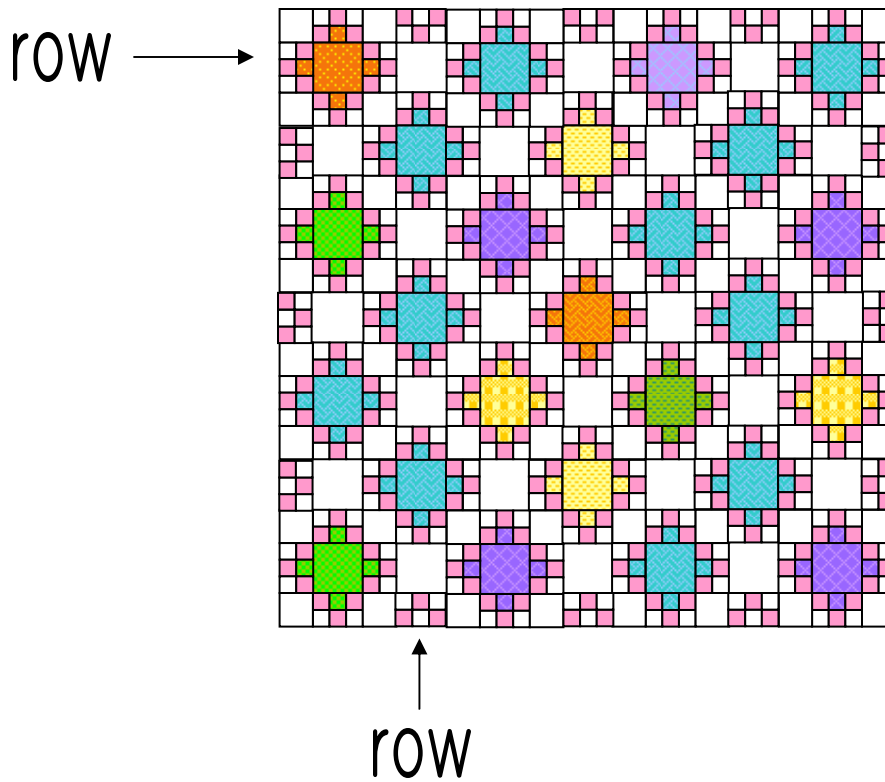


4. Choose 16 sets to be made into blocks. The remaining sets will be used to assemble the sashing and create the additional blocks.

5. Assemble 16 blocks as shown.



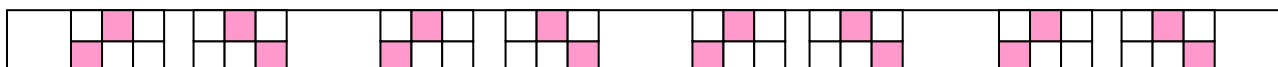
6. Using the remaining 9 sets, purple blocks, and 2x3 pink and white sets to assemble the inner quilt.

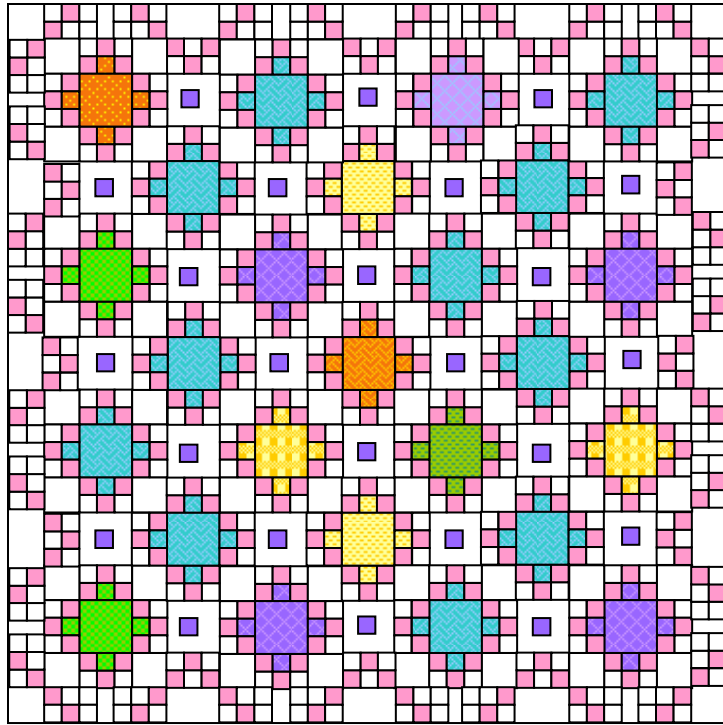


7. Join the remaining 4 patches and 3.5" x 5" rectangles to create the pieced border.

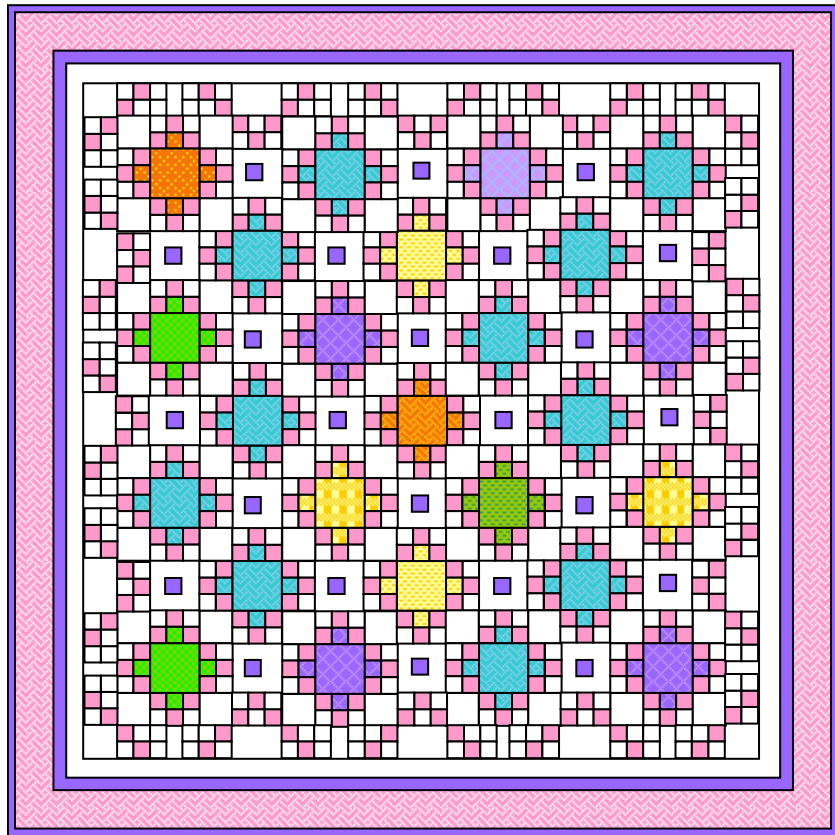


8. Attach 2 sides to quilt. Add a 3.5" white square to opposite ends of the two remaining side borders. Attach to quilt.





9. Attach small inner white border.
10. Attach inner purple border.
11. Attach outer turquoise border.



12. Quilt as desired.
13. Bind.
