



Butter Churn and Dash

Layout: 7 x 8, 56 blocks total

Finished Block Size: 7 1/2"

Finished Block Size: 63" x 71 1/2"

Fabric Requirements:

2 1/2 yards printed fabric

2 1/2 yards solids

1 1/4 yards small yellow print for sashing

1/4 yard red solid red for cornerstones

1/2 yard solid yellow

3/4 yard binding

Backing

Cutting Instructions:

**When we made this quilt, we used bonus triangles that we had from a previous project. We used the remnants from making the quilt to complete the blocks. You can make the quilt from bonus triangles that you may have or you can also use yardage or scraps that you already have.

Because we used bonus triangles, our color combinations had already been determined (green/pink, pink/turquoise, orange/pink, red/turquoise, red/green, orange/turquoise). You can choose predetermined color combinations or you can use the same solid throughout a block with scrappy backgrounds of the same color. The pattern is written to have the same solid with scrappy backgrounds of the same color.**

From Printed Fabrics:

- Cut a total of 112 3 7/8" squares
 - Set aside in sets of 2 similarly colored squares
- Cut a total of 280 2" squares
 - Set aside in sets of 5 similarly colored squares

From Solid Fabrics:

- Cut a total of 112 3 7/8" squares
 - Set aside in sets of 2
- Cut a total of 224 2" squares
 - Set aside in sets of 4

From Small Yellow Print:

- Cut a total of 26- 1 1/2" x WOF strips
 - Subcut into a total of 127- 1 1/2" x 8" rectangles

From Solid Red:

- Cut a total of 3- 1 1/2" x WOF strips
 - Subcut into a total of 72- 1 1/2" squares

From Solid Yellow:


- Cut a total of 7- 1 1/2" X WOF strips

From Binding:


- Cut a total of 7- 2 1/2" x WOF strips

Sewing Instructions:


1. To make one block, you will need 2 matching $3 \frac{7}{8}$ " solid squares and 2 coordinating $3 \frac{7}{8}$ " squares, 4- 2" solid squares, and 5 coordinating 2" squares.
2. Draw a line from corner to corner on each of the 2- $3 \frac{7}{8}$ " solid squares.
3. Match each solid $3 \frac{7}{8}$ " square with a printed $3 \frac{7}{8}$ " square. With right sides together, sew a quarter inch seam on each side of the drawn line. Cut on the drawn line and press to the solid fabric to yield a total of 4- half square triangles.



4. Join each of the solid 2" squares to a printed 2" square. Press to the solid square.




5. Assemble block as shown. Repeat to make a total of 56 blocks.



6. With sashing pieces and cornerstones, assemble middle of quilt as shown.

7. Join each of the $7-1 \frac{1}{2}$ " solid yellow strips on the bias. Measure quilt vertically through the middle. Cut two strips of the solid yellow fabric to this measurement. Attach to opposite sides of the quilt. Measure quilt horizontally through the middle. Press to the solid yellow border. Cut two strips of the solid yellow fabric to this measurement. Attach to the top and bottom of the quilt. Press to the solid yellow border.



8. Quilt as desired.

9. Join 7- 2 ½" x WOF strips on the bias. Bind.

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
