



Scrappy Stars Baby Quilt

You'll need:

1/2 yard teal fabric for cornerstones

Cut into 6 ~ 2 1/2" strips

sub cut into 16 ~ 2 1/2" squares set the remaining aside for binding strips.

3/4 yard for sashing

cut 8 ~ 2 1/2" strips

Subcut 24 ~ 2 1/2" x 12 1/2" pieces for the sashing

3/4 yard yellow background

Cut 4 ~ 3 1/2" strips

Subcut 36 ~ 3 1/2" squares

Cut 2 ~ 7 1/4" strip

Subcut into 9 ~ 7 1/4" squares. Cut on the diagonal twice making 36 triangles.

SCRAPS!!

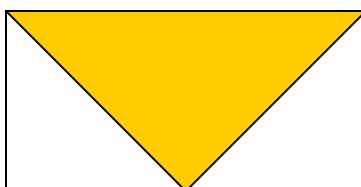
To make one block:

Start out by sewing random pieces of scraps together.

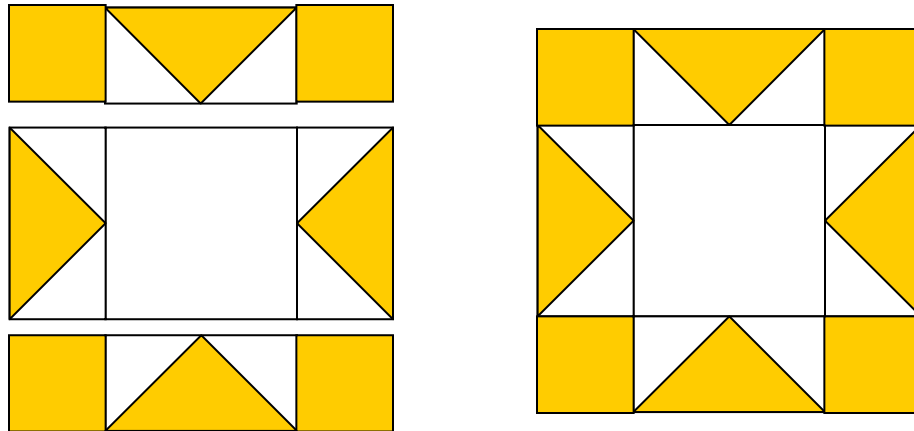
Piece enough so that you have a 6 1/2" square.

Piece more together until you have 4 ~ 3 7/8" squares. Cut in half on the diagonal.

Make the star points by sewing the scrappy triangles onto the yellow background triangle sewing on first one side, pressing and then the other side.



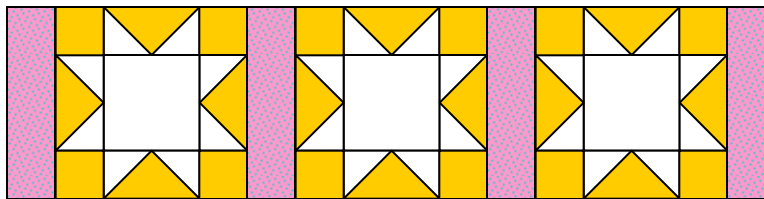
Assemble into rows then into a block. Repeat to make 9 blocks.



Assemble cornerstones and sashing as shown. Make 4.



Assemble blocks and sashing as shown. Make 3.



Assemble rows as shown to make the quilt top. Quilt. Bind.
