

A Star is Born!

Finished Quilt Size: 45 1/2"

Fabric Requirements:

1/3 yard Brown Prints

1 yard Assorted Colored Prints (at least 3 3/8" wide)

2 yards Solid Background

1/2 yard Binding

Backing

Cutting Instructions:

From Brown Prints:

Cut 1-5" x width of fabric strip

-Subcut into 4-5" squares

Cut 1-5 3/8" x width of fabric strip

-Subcut into 4- 5 3/8" squares

From Solid Background:

Cut 1-5" x width of fabric strip

-Subcut into 4-5" squares

Cut 1-5 3/8" x width of fabric strip

-Subcut into 4-5 3/8" squares

Cut 3-4" x width of fabric strips

-These strips will be used to border the center star

Cut 3-3" x width of fabric strips


-Subcut 1 strip into 8-3" squares

-Subcut 2 strips into 8-3" x 5 1/2" rectangles

Cut 10- 3 3/8" x width of fabric strips

-Subcut into 100- 3 3/8" squares





From Assorted Colored Prints:

Cut 10- 3 3/8" x width of fabric strips

-Subcut into 100- 3 3/8" squares

Sewing Instructions:

- 1. With right sides together, sew the colored 5" squares into 2 pairs of 2. Press
- 2. Join the segments created in step one to create a 4-patch.



3. Draw a line on the back of each of the 4-5 3/8" solid squares, connecting opposite corners. Pair each solid square with a brown 5 3/8" square. Sew a quarter inch on each side of the drawn line. Cut on the drawn line. Press to the brown to yield 8 brown and solid half square triangles.








4. Assemble center star as shown below.



5. Join the 3-4" x width of fabric solid strips. Measure your star horizontally through the middle. Cut 2 segments of the solid strip to this measurement. Attach to the top and bottom of the quilt. Press. Measure your quilt vertically through the middle. Cut 2 segments of the solid strip to this measurement. Attach to each side of the quilt. Press.



6. Draw a line connecting opposite corner of each of the solid 3 3/8" background squares. Match each solid square with a colored 3 3/8" square. Sew s quarter inch on each side of the drawn line. Cut on the drawn line. Press to the colored print to yield 200 solid and colored half square triangles.








7. Using 4- of the half square triangles created in step 6, make 48- 4 patches. There will be 8- half square triangles left over to be used in the corner units.




8. To make the corner units, attach a solid 3" square to one of the remaining half square triangles. Press to the solid square. Attach the 3" \times 5 1/2" rectangle to the solid side of the previously created unit. Press to the solid. Repeat to create 8 total corner units.




9. Join 5- 4-patches made in step 7. Make a total of 4.



10. Attach 2 inner border units to opposite sides of the star block. Press to the pieced inner border. Attach a corner unit to each of the remaining inner pieced borders. Attach to opposite sides of the bordered star. Press to the pieced border.



- 11. Join 7- 4-patches made in step 7. Make a total of 4.
- 12. Attach 2 outer border units to opposite sides of the quilt. Press to the outer pieced border. Attach a corner unit to each of the remaining outer pieced borders. Attach to opposite sides of the quilt. Press to the pieced border.



- 13. Quilt as desired. Jo used a brown thread on top and following this Youtube video for the quilting motif. https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=v0P1CE_d0qU
- 14. Join the 5-2 1/2" x width of fabric binding strips on the diagonal. Bind.
